**"The Challenge is Caries Control... Are you playing it safe or calculating your risks!"**

#### Course Description:

This program introduces the participant to CAMBRA - "Caries Management By Risk Assessment" to support identification of an individual's risk level for dental caries. Mapping a treatment plan is only successful when the dental team understands all factors that influence the caries pattern and prevalence based on medical history, lifestyle changes, behaviors and disease factors. Using several case studies that implement the use of CAMBRA, the participants will review and discuss how their dental team can select appropriate therapies and home-applied practices to reverse or minimize early carious patterns. Emphasis is given on recognizing the changing paradigm in preventive care and how the dental professional is responsible for keeping patients informed and healthier using a minimally-invasive approach to care.

**"I see your True Colors Shining Through - Cultural Competence for the Dental Profession"**

#### Course Description:

In a country of ever increasing diversity, effective client-centered health care will be realized only if clinicians are equipped to interact with and provide care for clients of varied cultural backgrounds. The culturally competent oral health provider is cognizant of the fact that cultural diversity means far more than just ethnicity, and reaching all groups with various barriers is one of dentistry's greatest challenges. This session will present cultural

diversity issues, how dental hygienists can become more culturally competent in patient care and ways to use this knowledge for addressing access to care barriers among the population groups discussed. Those delivering effective, empathetic health care must be cognizant of the values, beliefs and attitudes toward health that people from various populations hold. Communication with diverse groups depends upon incorporating respect for and knowledge of these ideals. Different models of cultural competency will be explained, and a variety of diverse populations will be discussed.
