"When the Body Turns on Itself: Autoimmune Disease"

The concept is terrifying, and the enemy comes from within. Diseases where the body's own natural defense cells begin attacking other cells within their own body are autoimmune diseases. They are the third most common major illness in the U.S. after cancer and heart disease, and the eighth leading cause of death for women aged 15 to 84. Women are 2.7 times more likely than men to acquire an autoimmune disease. Women have enhanced immune systems as compared to men, which increases women's resistance to many types of infection but also makes them more susceptible to autoimmune diseases. This course will review how the immune system works, and will discuss some of the autoimmune diseases, such as systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE), rheumatoid arthritis (RA), scleroderma, fibromyalgia, and type 1 diabetes. It will review the role of estrogen and inflammatory aspects of autoimmune diseases. Patients with autoimmune diseases have specific oral and dental problems associated with the disease process and the medications needed to control the disease symptoms. These issues, and some practical tips for clinical practice, will be discussed.
